





- > Less advanced features
- > Focus on simplicity



- > Desktop apps
- > Advanced features
- > Accessible anywhere

Enterprise data management

- > Google Drive
 - Shared Drives
- > Data stored globally
- > Data is pooled (2TB per user)
- > Better for unstructured data and data search
- > If an organisation is storing a lot of shared company data then Google will be significantly less expensive



- > SharePoint
- > OneDrive
- > Can request for data to be stored in Australia
- > Limited per service (e.g. 1TB for SharePoint)
- > Better for structured data

Ease of use

- > Build for simplicity
- > Small learning curve
- > All main applications can be accessed through Google Drive
- > Simple integration with 3rd party applications + mobile



- > More sophisticated features
- > Steeper learning curve
- > Single sign-on
- > Better integration with Windows devices


